Door Care Guide







Keep your door looking its best all year round with these easy instructions.



Thank you for choosing an Apeer Door.

Your Apeer Door is virtually maintenance free. To keep it in pristine condition and operating correctly here is a helpful guide to periodic cleaning and care for you to keep and refer to.

Cleaning

Painted finish, foiled and PVC frame. The outside of your door in particular is exposed to the elements and environment. Remove any contaminants or dirt periodically using mild soapy water and a soft cloth. For stubborn dirt use a microfiber cloth to get into the grain of the door. Rinse with clean water until soap residue is removed. Dry with a lint free cloth. Never use cream cleaners, solvents, abrasives, bleach, acetone, scouring pads or steam or high pressure washers to clean your Apeer Door. These could damage the product and invalidate the warranty.

Door Furniture

Clean periodically with mild soapy water and a soft cloth and rinse with clean water.

Keys

To prevent damage to the painted finish avoid leaving large bunches of keys hanging in the door. If you need any additional keys speak to your installer who will advise.

Lubrication

Locks and Cylinders should be lubricated bi-annually. This should be done using light oil such as 3 in 1 or Graphite or Teflon spray. Under no circumstances use penetrating sprays such as WD-40

Stainless Steel

If you have chosen Stainless Steel furniture or trims on your Apeer door you will want to keep these in pristine order too. Stainless Steel does not rust. However vou should clean stainless steel items periodically to remove any contaminants that could lead to 'Tea Staining'. This is best done using a regular house hold domestic stainless steel cleaner available in most supermarkets. Follow the manufacturer's instructions using a soft cloth or 'Scotchbrite' pad for stubborn stains cleaning in the direction of the grain only. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and dry with a soft cloth. Under no circumstances use steel wool to clean Stainless Steel

Hinge Cover Caps

Please ensure your door hinges have all the hinge caps secured in place at the top of the hinge. Hinge caps lock in the adjustment and are an integral part of the performance of the door so it's important they are fitted properly.
